## \$892,196 for Auto Injuries

Anner v. Passman: A Sayreville man who suffered neck injuries in an auto accident accepted \$892,196 to settle his Middlesex County suit on May 6.

On March 6, 2007, Christopher Anner was at a stop sign on Kimball Drive at the intersection of Main Street and Kimball Drive in Sayreville when Renee Passman, driving south on Main Street, lost control of her Chevrolet Impala, which hit a traffic island, became airborne and landed on Anner's car.

Anner, now 42, suffered two herniated neck discs and post-traumatic stress disorder and could not return to his school custodian job, says his lawyer, **Michael Percario** of Linden.

Passman, who was not injured, claimed that Anner's herniated discs were degenerative and caused by colitis. Superior Court Judge **Heidi Willis Currier** granted Anner summary judg-

ment on liability on April 25.

Passman's lawyer, **Richard Astorino** of **Edward Hoagland**'s office in Mount Laurel, did not return a call.
